Blaine Staggs sets West Coast Tour record in route to victory

Blaine Staggs, a former assistant professional at The Sycuan Resort turned touring pro, lapped the field Tuesday with a phenomenal round of 6-under 65 (WCT modified par of 71) at Cross Creek G.C. On a course that proved to be a stern test for the majority of the field, Staggs carded 8 birdies on the day, including 5 on the front nine to give him an early lead that he would never relinquish. His WCT single-round record setting performance earned him the 4-shot victory over fellow competitor Jeremy Tucker as well as the \$975 1st place paycheck. Finishing in 3rd place and earning the last paycheck in the field was Don Hildre with a solid round of 70.

All under par rounds fired by the top 3 finishers came in spite of difficult conditions Tuesday, which included some very cool, windy surroundings throughout most of the round. The West Coast Tour now looks forward to next week when Arroyo Trabuco G.C. will host the 3rd event on the WCT Winter Series schedule in Mission Viejo, CA.
